“ Kenny’s Journey

Kenneth De’yont Goins, 43, of Salisbury, Maryland, departed this life on Saturday, April 27, 2024. Kenny was the only beloved son of Kennie and Tonia Jones. He was affectionately known as Heart by his family.

As a child Kenny attended Love, Faith, and Deliverance Ministries pastored by his grandparents, Reverend Professor Charles and Evangelist Ruth Taylor. He gave his life to Christ at a young age and delivered his first sermon at 10 years old.

Kenny received his formal education through the Wicomico public school system. He participated in a variety of sports and his family enjoyed watching him play little league baseball, youth league soccer, and basketball. Kenny attended Dean Smith’s Carolina Basketball School in the summer of 1996 located on the campus of the University of North Carolina. The following year, he played basketball with coach Bruce Wharton at James M. Bennett High School. In 1998, Kenny graduated from Wicomico High School in Salisbury, Maryland.

Soon after graduating high school, Kenny enlisted in the military and became a member of the United States Army. He was stationed at Fort Sill, in Lawton, Oklahoma. While enlisted, Kenny competed on one of the top-ranked basketball teams at the base.

After being honorably discharged, Kenny enrolled in the Leadership Development Training Program under the leadership of Dr. Myles Munroe. This training led him to desire and acquire his real estate license. Soon after, many of his friends began to recognize his entrepreneurial spirit and drive for success. This gave birth to the nickname “Kount” (\$\$\$).

Kenny loved people! He had a genuine concern for helping anyone that needed a hand or an encouraging word. Kenny loved family! Every move he made, every breath he took was to see his family in a better position and in a better condition. He cherished his parents and his children and bragged about them to all of his friends. If you weren’t family, and Kenny liked you, you became family. As a gifted leader in our family, he would often reach out to his cousins and friends to get an update on their “state of mind.,” and then offer wise

counsel, direction, and encouragement.

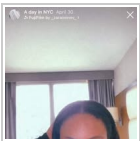
