Lawrence Niskey Sr., was born Friday, November 9, 1928, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, to the late Esther Niskey. He went home to be with the Lord on January 21, 2020.

He attended secondary school in Princess Anne, Maryland, and later went on to earn his Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Maryland Eastern Shore (UMES) and began a career as an educator. He also earned his Master of Science degree from Virginia State College and continued his graduate education at the University of Wisconsin. Later, he taught at the higher education level. Lawrence taught for many years in the Maryland and Virginia public school systems, where he touched the lives of many students. Later in life, he went on to work for Sea Watch International, as a quality control technician, where he retired.

Lawrence served his country, during the Korean War, in the United States Army as a combat engineer, while stationed in Germany.

In his leisure, Lawrence enjoyed going fishing, working in his vegetable garden, trying out new recipes to cook and playing with the family's yellow lab. He also loved crab feasts and get-togethers with family and friends. He enjoyed sports, especially watching basketball, football and horse racing.

Lawrence also had a passion for doing carpentry work, home repairs/fixing things around the house and working on the car. He enjoyed reading Popular Mechanics magazine. He had a knack for understanding how things worked and he could fix almost anything when it broke. He was always there to help relatives and friends or others that were in need of help.

Lawrence was preceded in death by his mother, Esther and his wife of 63 years, Nina.
