Lillian Virginia Dashiell Maston, 84, was born April 6, 1930 and slipped from life into eternal rest on Friday, January 9, 2015 at Dorchester General Hospital in Cambridge, Maryland.

She also loved good seafood, good gospel music, she loved to dance and enjoyed chewing gum. Lillian was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, cousin and friend. She remembered everybody's birthday, she would make sure she had all addresses lined up with each birth date and would "Always" send a card as well as giving you a real "EARLY MORNING SINGING CALL" before she left to go to the Community Center. She enjoyed traveling to California to visit with her son, Ricky and would have many stories when she returned. Her favorite color was purple and her favorite song, "Precious Lord!"
