Linda P. Miller (Weatherly), daughter of Fred and Willie Mae Weatherly, was born on Thursday, April 22, 1954, in Exmore, Virginia. She passed away, surrounded by her loving family, on Wednesday, June 23, 2021. She attended Delaware Technical & Community College in Georgetown, Delaware, where she received her G.E.D. and completed college courses.

Linda retired from Orthopedic Associates in Lewes, Delaware, in December of 2017. She was a people-person and made friends with everyone whom she encountered. Linda was a constant talker and the glue that held her family together. She would always encourage her children, grandchildren, nieces, nephews, brothers, sisters and cousins. Linda was always willing to give advice to anyone who asked and even to those who did not ask. She enjoyed going to the family reunions. In addition, she was a huge Philadelphia Eagles fan.

Linda was a member of Faith United Methodist Church, Rehoboth, Delaware, where she served as a member of the United Methodist Women and Finance Committee.
