disabled adults. Lucille was a proud member of Gould, later bought by Martin Marietta. There she served her country by manufacturing machinery to be used by

the United States Government. Lucille held various jobs throughout her life, however

her most rewarding was as a mother, raising her children and four of her grandchildren.

Lucille, affectionately called “Mom” by many and “Celie” by family was a light to

every room and every person she touched. She shared her love of music, infinite

wisdom, and infectious humor with family and friends alike. Her bubbly laughter and
