### Obituary

Major L. Richardson, Jr., affectionately known as “Buddy,” peacefully departed this life on Wednesday, April 23, 2025, at the age of eighty-eight (88).

Born on May 24, 1936, he was the beloved son of the late Major Richardson, Sr. and Annie Richardson. He received his early education through the North Hampton County Public School system. Following his graduation from high school, Major proudly served his country as a paratrooper in the United States Army.

After his military service, he relocated to Salisbury, Maryland, where he built a life rooted in hard work and dedication. He was employed by Campbell Soup Company and Taylor Oil Company and later found his long-term professional home at Aerial Crane Service, where he worked faithfully for over thirty (30) years.

On February 22, 1969, Major was united in holy matrimony to the late Judy Richardson. Together, they were not only partners in life but also in business, co-owning several local establishments including Salisbury Music Hall, Peninsula Taxi, Tilly’s Restaurant and Peninsula Busing Company. Their shared entrepreneurial spirit left a lasting impact on their family and

Major had a deep love for his family and took great joy in spending time with them. He loved sharing stories from his time in the Army and had a passion for jazz and soul music that never faded.
