Marcylee Ginn Dedrick, the daughter of the late Raymond Agent Ginn and Ella Collick Ginn, was born on Saturday, September 10, 1932. She entered into her eternal rest 7:45 am on Saturday, July 29, 2023, at Atlantic General Hospital in Berlin, Maryland.

Marcie, as she preferred to be called, attended Stephen Long Elementary School and graduated from Worcester High School in the Class of 1949. At an early age, she joined Shiloh United Methodist Church. An active and faithful member, she served on the Council on Ministries, Usher Board, Senior Citizens Club and Building Fund Committee. Marcie never met a stranger, and was loved by all who knew her. If you were in need, she was there to help in anyway she could. She loved being with her family and barbecues and family dinners were her specialties. There was never a shortage of food, fun or family.
