Margaret's Life and Legacy

Margaret F. Collins entered this world on June 14, 1930 in Middle Town, North Carolina, as the third child of the late Emory Fulford and Annie Fulford Spencer. God dispatched His angels to take her from earth to glory early Saturday morning, June 22, 2024. She was blessed to have seen her 94th birthday on June 14, 2024.

She received her education in the public school system of Hyde County, North Carolina.

After her marriage to the late Thomas Collins, they made their home in Stockton, Maryland and from this union, four children were born.

During her lifetime, Margaret was a seafood worker, a field worker, and finally she became a cook. Her last place of employment was at Evelyn's Village Inn in Snow Hill, Maryland. She was well-known for her sweet potato pies, crab cakes, and fried chicken.

She was baptized at an early age at Faithful Hannah Baptist Church in Middle Town, North Carolina. After moving to Maryland, she moved her membership to Mount Hope Baptist Church, where she remained a faithful member until
