On June 20, 2016, an angel from Heaven was sent to claim the soul of one of God's children, Marjarine Virginia Summers. She was born on December 31, 1931 to Jacob and Clara Sudler of Smyrna, Delaware.

A lifelong resident of Smyrna, Delaware, Marjarine attended school in Smyrna and Booker T. Washington High School. She retired from Stevenson's Funeral Home after 30 years of dedicated service.
