Mark A. Blue was born to the late Melvin H. Blue and Alma Blue in Wheeling, West Virginia, on January 10, 1951. He departed this life on August 1, 2018, at 67 years old. He was a loving and caring husband, father, grandfather and brother.

Mark attended and graduated from East Technical High School in Cleveland, Ohio. He enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1973 and retired in 1993. He attended Basic Training at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas and Technical School at Chanute Air Force Base, Rantoul, Illinois. During his 20 years of service, Mark's favorite tours were in Okinawa, Japan and Dover Air Force Base, Delaware.

In 1994, Mark began his second career with the State of Delaware as a Correctional Officer. He was assigned to the Howard R. Young Correctional Facility in Wilmington, Delaware, where he served more than 21 years. Mark officially retired in September 2015.
