



## Marvin Lee Beulah

April 22, 1959 - April 30, 2024

Marvin Lee Beulah of Denton, MD peacefully departed his life on Tuesday, April 22, 2024 at Compass Hospice Center in Centerville, MD. He was 65 years old. He was the son of the late Melvin Beulah of Pinetown, MD and the late Gloria Jean Beulah (Smith) of Cordova, MD, Marvin resided in Denton for the majority of his life.

Marvin was educated at North Caroline High School, Denton, MD. He graduated with the Class of 1977. In high school Marvin was known for his football ability, agility and speed. He worked for Orion of Easton, MD for many years. He then was employed by The Talbot County Public Schools as the Head Custodian for Tilghman Elementary School for several years. He was loved by all of the students and staff that worked there. They were not just his co-workers, but they were his friends as well. It was because of his health, Marvin had to retire in May of 2019. It was not what he wanted to do but he knew that was what he had to do.

For those that knew Marvin, knew that his passion was teaching karate to others to build their confidence and self-esteem. He studied under the Order of Isshinryu for over 20

years. It was under this study Marvin earned his 5th degree black belt. He worked very hard for this title and was very proud of it. Marvin opened his own dojo, Ring of Fire, under this study in Trappe, MD. Marvin then went to study at Brickhouse Martial Arts of Salisbury, MD. He taught class there as well. Marvin was also a big advocate for self -defense. He believed everyone should be taught how to defend themselves when and if the opportunity arose. His children studied with him in his earlier years but his youngest hung in there and is currently a red belt under Brickhouse Martial Arts. Marvin was a huge Ravens fan. He loved his precious Ravens. No one could talk ill about them. Marvin also enjoyed fishing. He would find little fishing holes to go fishing but trust and believe he was not going to tell you about them. He kept them all a secret.

Marvin leaves to mourn three children: Marvin Lydell Beulah, LaCree Beulah (Joel Meford) and Devin Beulah all of Denton, MD; special friends that always held a special place in his heart: Camille Blake, Troy Purnell, Gregory Sanchez, Angie Asmussen, Austin Langdon and the late Frank Brown. Marvin had a host of cousins and friends that will miss him dearly.
