positions at the church such as: communion steward, senior choir, usher board, homecoming committee and trustee chairman. She was a faithful member until her health no longer permitted her to remain active. She also attended Cathedral of Deliverance and Rapture Ready Ministries, Inc. churches where she enjoyed fellowshiping and worshipping God. Many times you could hear her praising God with an "Amen" or "Yea". She loved listening to music, reading the newspaper and working word searches. She attended Shady Pines Adult Day Care Center in Salisbury, Maryland, where she enjoyed the fellowship and wonderful staff.

She was affectionately called by family and friends "Mom Mary". Although a woman of few words, she often mentioned her age to family members to remind them of why she was moving slow. She loved her children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, great-great children and often was present at Sunday dinners or church gatherings. Her last years were spent living with her daughter Andrea Price where she remained until entering the nursing home.
