The home going celebration of our loved one, Mary Ida Taylor, has left a void in our hearts as she departed this life for our heavenly home on Saturday, April 19, 2014 at Bayhealth Medical Center in Dover, DE after suffering a short illness. She was 82 years old.

Mary was born a twin on December 24, 1931 in Millsboro, DE to the late Herbert and Florence Burton. Mary received her education within the Millsboro School District.
