Mervin Samuel Schoolfield was born July 24, 1943 to the late William David Schoolfield and Lorraine Mathews Schoolfield in Salisbury, Maryland. He departed this life on March 17, 2021 at Tidal Health Peninsula Regional Center after a short illness.
