Muriel was a traveler and loved people. She liked to support couples in what to do in order to have a successful marriage. One of her co-worker (Shelly Parchment) would state she always had a word of advise for my marriage and something wrapped in foil paper. (Muze) as she was often called would love to have company over and love to make sure everyone was fed and comfy. She would always asked: Carol does everyone have to leave?"
