### A Life Remembered

Dr. Norman Reginald Anderson, Sr. passed peacefully onto Glory on Tuesday, January 22, 2019.

Born in Salisbury, Maryland on February 3, 1947 to the late James Albert Anderson of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and the late Marion Alvenia Jones of Chance, Maryland, he was the oldest of seven siblings and was preceded in death by his step-father, Felton Johnson, brother Tyrone, and sister Victoria. Dr. Anderson graduated from Somerset Jr.-Sr. High School, Princess Anne, Maryland and attended Morgan State University where he earned his Bachelor of Arts degree. He earned his doctorate degree from the University of Maryland College Park. He was a member of Delta Omicron Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity in Princess Anne.

Norman taught in the Baltimore City Public School System. Upon returning to the Eastern Shore, he was employed at Shore Up! Inc. as Director of Operations and later at the University of Maryland Eastern Shore where he was Director of Procurement and later Director of the Physical Plant.

Left to mourn Dr. Anderson's passing are his son, N. Reginald Anderson II (Honolulu, Hawaii), his daughter, Brandi Anderson (Newark DE), his four

sisters, Sharon Hankerson, Eden, MD (Roger); Gail Holbrook, Mt. Vernon (Mitchell); Cynthia Nichols, Seaford, DE (Graylon); and his brother, Felton Johnson, Jr. (Baltimore, MD).
