OTIS' JOURNEY

Otis was born on November 12, 1931 in Wattsville, Virginia to the late George and Flora Poole, one of seven siblings. On Saturday January 7, 2023 at 6:09 am, heaven dispatched the angel of mercy to accompany home God's child. He was a resident of the Alice B. Tawes Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Crisfield, Maryland, while absent from his home in New Church, Virginia.

Otis accepted Jesus Christ at an early age. He attended Wattsville United Methodist Church in Wattsville, VA and was one of seven siblings who were led to Christ by their parents. Otis received his education through the Accomack County Public School System.

Otis and Grace joined hands in Holy Matrimony on March 16, 1962 (60 years and 10 months of marriage).

The Ceremony was performed by the late Reverend Benjamin Burton.

During many years of his life, he did farm work, with his father going on to work for Shell Poultry, then Holly Farms in Temperanceville, VA where he started his new job as an Eviscerating Supervisor. Then Holly farms became Tyson Foods and between the three he retired with 60 plus years of service. Otis never missed a day of work and never complained about going to work. After retiring from the poultry industry, he went to work at the Rest Area at the Maryland/Virginia Line for a few years before giving work up.

There was not a job in the house that he wouldn't do. When the wife awakened in the morning, the breakfast was done. He always tried to help keep the house in order. At the nursing home, he would accompany the nurse while delivering medication, keeping busy. Sunday morning waking up early ready for worship service, Wednesday morning service with Pastor Steve. He would say to us you missed some good singing if we were late.

Otis was known by family and friends for his very particular appearance, keeping a clean

vehicle and managing a well-maintained yard. Otis cared especially for plants and flowers. In his younger days, some pleasures were going to the drag race, riding his motor bike and drinking beer, one after another, and never getting a buzz, that we could notice. While living at Tawes Nursing and Rehabilitation Center for one year and three months, the staff and residents shared with us how much they came to love Otis. His roommate said he was just a piece of on the floor when it came to Mr. Otis. When Mr. Otis called the CNA or Nurse, they came to take care of the situation immediately. They would all say, "Grace he calls for you early every morning and sometimes throughout the day; especially the day that you are coming to visit.

He was preceded in death by: his parents, George and Flora Poole; daughter, Barbara Poole; brothers, Reginald and Purcel Poole; sisters, Augusta Holly, Stephanie Robins and Hattie Davis; aunts, Hattie Selby and Bernice Marshall and uncle, John Poole.
