Ovon Rhonda (Giddins) Jernigan departed this world on Wednesday, January 4, 2017. She was 47 years old. Ovon was born on Monday, February 17, 1969 at Milford Memorial Hospital in Milford, Delaware to Lena V. Giddins and the late Otas Cephas, Sr.

Her early childhood education began at East Millsboro Elementary School and then completed at Sussex Central High School. She graduated in 1987 and furthered her education at Polytech in Woodside, Delaware as a Dental Assistant, then as a Certified Nursing Assistant. During Ovon's younger years, she attended Dickerson Chapel African Methodist Episcopal Church and was a part of the Y.P.D. (Young People's Department). She was also a member of the Usher Board and Director of the Youth Choir.
