Paul E. Gary, Sr. 'Bolden' of Smyrna, Delaware departed this life on Saturday, April 12, 2014 at Bay Health-Kent General Hospital in Dover. Paul was born on May 11, 1929 in Jackson, North Carolina to Sidney Gary and Bettie McNair. He received his education in North Hampton County, North Carolina, after which he traveled to New York where he joined the United States Army National Guard. After a few years of service, Paul was honorably discharged. He later found employment with J.S. Blank & Company, a menswear manufacturer. After 44 years of dedicated work, Paul retired, looking forward to spending time with his family.
