Elder RALPH HERSHEY PAULK, SR., son of the late William Jefferson Paulk and Faye Paulk, was born in Douglas, Georgia on December 1, 1947. He departed this earthly life suddenly, and entered life eternal on Thursday, December 11, 2014 at his home in Salisbury, Maryland.

He received his formal education in the Atkinson County public schools in Georgia, graduating in 1968. He then continued his education in college and was drafted into the United States Army for four (4) years.

After years of living in Georgia, he relocated to Salisbury, Maryland in 1979 after he met his lovely wife Shirley Ann Paulk at the Lock & Load Juke joint. Years later he turned his life over to Christ, which later led to his ordination as a minister at New Jerusalem Church in Cambridge, Maryland under the tutelage of Bishop Clarence Cornish.
