Remona Cardoza, born in Cambridge, Maryland on Saturday, November 29, 1941, was the daughter of the late Lillie and Allen Camper.

Upon completion of her classes, Remona became a Certified Nursing Assistant, and was then employed by Greenwich Hospital in Greenwich, Connecticut, a position she held for many years.

At the age of 79, Remona still had the desire to work: "hustle", she called it. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Remona spent her last few months, at home.
