Richard was educated in the public school system of Somerset County, Maryland. He learned mechanics by attending Vo-Tech during high school. Richard attended Flower Hill United Methodist Church in Eden, Maryland for a short while and would ride his bicycle to church. In the later years, Richard became a member of New Psalmist Nondenominational Church in Westover, Maryland.
