Robert Briggs Hamilton, 86, of Salisbury, MD departed this life on the evening of Saturday, September 16, 2023, at Tidal Health Peninsula Regional Hospital. Robert Briggs Hamilton was born August 22, 1937 in Paw Paw, West Virginia to the late Forrest Briggs Hamilton and the late Lucille (Bullett) Hamilton Holmes. He was the 4th child of 5 born to the Hamilton family.

Robert attended the public schools of Paw Paw, West Virginia and Dunbar High School in Baltimore, Maryland. Upon moving to Salisbury, Maryland, Robert was employed by Steins of Salisbury and later employed by Campbell's Soup Company as a Line Supervisor from 1964 until retiring on February 1, 1994. to play and sing. He also enjoyed listening to gospel quartets like the Mighty Clouds of Joy. Some of his favorite pastimes were fishing, playing music, and playing baseball with the Salisbury Tigers and softball for the Campbell's Soupers.

He leaves to cherish his memory, three sons; Johnathan Hamilton of Salisbury, MD, Jerry Hamilton, Sr. of New Jersey, and Alfred Brown of Salisbury, MD. He also leaves two sisters; Kathleen I.
