Robert "Bobby" Mollock of Delmar, Delaware, passed away peacefully on February 14, 2026, surrounded by loved ones. Born June 1, 1944, in Cambridge, Maryland, to Mary Alice Jones and Milton Mollock, Bobby was married for 48 years to Dorothy Aguirre Mollock.

A devoted father and mentor, he helped raise 36 children and was deeply involved in his community.
