Robert Lee Price, at the age of sixty-eight (68), was unexpectedly called into eternal rest on May 20, 2024, at his home in Easton, Maryland.

Robert was born on December 8, 1955 in Talbot County, Maryland. As an infant, he was adopted by the late Thursetta Young Price and Robert R. Price.
