



Robert L. Ruffin Sr.

January 28, 1947 - June 6, 2013

GEORGETOWN - Robert L. Ruffin Sr, 66, passed away June 6, 2013 at the Delaware Hospice Center, Milford.

He was born in Laurel, Delaware to Ida Virginia Ruffin Morris and the late George Parker. He was preceded in death by two brothers John Ruffin and Timothy Morris.

Robert was a 1965 graduate of Jason High School, Georgetown. He was also a recipient of a Registered Nursing Diploma from Beebe School of Nursing – Class of 1976 - where he was honored to be one of the first male graduates in the school's history.

He joined the U.S. Army in 1966 and served 5 years of active duty (2 years overseas); reaching the rank of SP5.

After completion of his military service, Mr. Ruffin worked as a State of Delaware employee for over two decades serving as the 2nd shift nursing supervisor at Stockley Center in Georgetown and a member of the Mobile Crisis Unit in Milford. In both of these roles he was known to be a fun and dedicated employee who was committed to providing the upmost care and respect to all patients. Upon retirement in 2002 he focused on his favorite things, spending time with his family and friends, fishing, watching birds, and

enjoying the beauty of nature.

Robert was a member of St. Matthew First Baptist Church in Laurel and a supporter of Prospect AME church in Georgetown.

In addition to his mother Ida, he is survived by his son Robert, daughter-in-law Kerry and two granddaughters Nicole and Sienna Ruffin.
