### The Life of Rony Oneus

Rony Oneus was born on Thursday, August 19, 1993 in Petit-Goave, Haiti to Renoville Oneus and Filicia Rosias. He passed away on Wednesday, November 13, 2024 in Saint Joseph, Missouri. Rony attended school in Port-au-Prince, Haiti until the 12th grade.

Rony worked as a truck driver for the past 6 years.

When he was born, his sister Nanay who was only 3 years at the time, admired how bright and beautiful he was and called him "Ti-Lalin" meaning Little Moon. Almost everyone continued to call him his nickname until he was a teenager. He spent many years with his brothers, Yvenson and Sergely, with their many adventures in Haiti. After Yvenson passed away in 2004, they transitioned from being the Three Musketeers to the Dynamic Duo. Being the older brother of 2 boys helped him to be a father when he had at his first son, Ronald Roothanley Oneus, in May 2012. When he moved to the states in March 2015, he always remained super close and connected to his brother Sergely.

On September 2015, Rony started pursuing Caela via WhatsApp. But if you know Rony, words were not his strong suit and Serge had to help with writing messages to Caela before she finally said yes to him. Rony could not wait to

finally meet her face-to-face, so in April 2016 he went to Haiti. He fell in love with her even more when he finally saw her face-to-face. He proposed to her in May 2019 and they welcomed their first child together on January 2023. Rony was so excited to have another son. He loved and adored his 2 sons, Ronald and Rony, Jr. Although Ronald is only 12 years old, Rony had already bought him a car to teach him to drive.

Rony was a son, father, brother, nephew, cousin and friend to many. Rony loved his family and often showed it with random calls, texts, and house visits, especially those who are overseas. Rony could talk for hours about his dreams to spoil his mom, giving her the world. Rony truly enjoyed spending time with family and watching different sporting events.

Rony was kind, respectful, funny, and loved caring for other people. Even with his passing, he generously donated his organs to save the lives of those who are in need of an organ and/or tissue transplant.

Rony was preceded in death by: his maternal grandparents, Filianna Orelie and Elias Rosias; his paternal grandparents, Charitable Jean-Baptiste and Renome Oneus; younger sister, Lanssika Oneus and his younger brother, Yvenson Oneus.

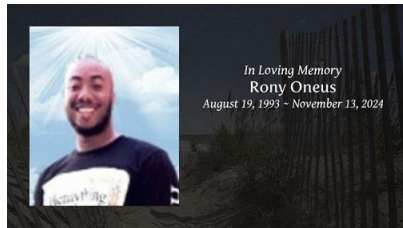
