Ruth Mae Cannon Carr, was born April 6, 1932, to the late Lena Idella Smith and Randolph Tull, of Salisbury, Maryland. She departed this life at the age of 86, and entered her enteral rest, on May 24, 2018, at home, in Dover, Delaware.

Ruth's early childhood was spent in Salisbury, Maryland, with her mother and stepfather, Coulbourne Cannon. She was educated in Wicomico County Schools and graduated from Salisbury High School in 1948.

Ruth's service at Morning Star included the Mothers Board and president of the Christian Education Department. At the time of her death, she was a member of Bibleway Institutional C.O.G.I.C., Bishop Thomas L. Holsey, pastor.

In addition to her parents, Ruth was preceded in death by her husband of 53 years, Berley L. Carr; her only brother, Clayton Cannon; and her youngest son, Michael K. Carr.
