Samuel E. Brooks, II also lovingly known as "Fatman", son of the late Eleanor Leona Hawkins and Samuel E. Benson departed this life on August 18, 2015. He was born on June 11, 1952 in Chestertown, Maryland.

He was educated in the Kent County Public School System and received his education at Booker T. Washington Elementary School and William Henry High School in Dover, Delaware. He dedicated over 20 years of his life to counseling youth and families in several states. He cared deeply for children and families in need and held a special place in his heart for children with special needs. He also started the "Green Team," a youth based community program for children of single parent households of Capital Green and other communities in Dover such as Capital Park.

Sam was a member of the ThunderGuards organization and later founded the family, faith, and service oriented motorcycle social club, Kamau. One of his proudest accomplishments was riding his Harley cross country to California. He was a member of Victory Baptist Church in Bridgeville, Delaware under the leadership of his good friend, Pastor Russ Kessler.

He is preceded in death by his stepfather, Augustine "Pop" Hawkins and sisters, Peggy Maria Brooks Ukpabi and Gloria Griffin.
