Storer accepted Christ as his Savior at an early age under the leadership of the late Reverend Washington. He joined the members of Haven United Methodist Church and served as Trustee, member of the United Men's Choir and a member of the Administration Board. He loved his church and would always see to the upkeep of the building until the members merged and became Lee Haven United Methodist Church.
