Tolbert Sylvester Harris, 65, of Dover, departed this life Tuesday, December 8, 2015 at Kent General Hospital of natural causes. Tolbert was born July 28, 1950 to parents (both now deceased) Tolbert Harmon and Anna Mae Harris-Scarborough.
