Troy Donnell Rose, Sr., at the age of fifty (50), passed from earth to glory on Monday, March 4, 2024, at Tidal Health Hospital in Salisbury, MD.

He was born to Rose M. Rose and the late Terry Rose, Sr., on August 4, 1973, at Dorchester General Hospital in Cambridge, MD. After completing school in Wicomico County Public Schools, upon graduation he enlisted in the United States Marine Corp for four years. During that time, Troy served in Bosnia, Somalia, and Afghanistan wars. When Troy returned from his service, he was a Wounded Warrior.
