February 16, 1949 - January 22, 2018

Tyrone Eugene Reese Sr. was born on February 16, 1949 in Chestertown, MD to the late Martha Fenwick Reese and Leon T. Reese. Tyrone quietly passed away at home on January 22, 2018. He was 68 years old, the eldest and the only son of this union. Tyrone was preceded in death by one brother, Thomas "Sonny" Kilson.

The Reese family moved to Church Hill, Maryland, when Tyrone was five years old. He was raised in Church Hill and attended Kennard Elementary, Kennard High and Queen Anne County High School. Tyrone was quite a popular guy at QACHS, where this lefty showcased his love of baseball by ruling first base. He was a member of the first graduating class of QACHS in 1967.

Tyrone continued to play baseball with a community league for many years. He never lost his love for the game and was an avid Los Angeles Dodger fan. He also enjoyed cheering on his favorite basketball and football teams, the Los Angeles Lakers and the Washington Redskins!

After graduation, Tyrone was employed at the Campbell Soup Company and moved from Church Hill to Chestertown. He remained at Campbell Soup for the next 28 years, until the company closed in 1995. He also worked for Hanover Frozen Food. He later returned to the old Campbell Soup facility,

which reopened as Chestertown Foods, until it closed in 2008.
