Tyvette's Life Story

Tyvette Lavolia Brown, endearingly known as “Tyvee”, passed away in the early morning of Wednesday, October 12, 2022 at TidalHealth Peninsula Regional Medical Center in Salisbury, Maryland at the age of forty-one (41).

Tyvette was born on Sunday, December 21, 1980 in Northampton-Accomac Memorial Hospital in Nassawadox, Virginia, to the parents of William Henry Ward, Jr. and Hilda W. Harmon. Throughout Tyvette’s upbringing, she was raised by her mother Hilda, her late father William, and her step-mother Phyllis Hammond.

Tyvette graduated from Sussex Tech High School of Delaware in June 1998 after having also attended Stephen Decatur High School in Berlin, Maryland from which she pursued cosmetology training at Worcester Technical School in Worcester County, Maryland. After graduation, Tyvette pursued an Associates degree in Early Childhood Education at Delaware Technical Community College. Shortly thereafter, Tyvette pursued a professional career as a Bank Teller and Personal Banker in what is now known as M&T Bank in Delaware and Maryland. Tyvette also consistently served in the local church assemblies she attended throughout her upbringing and adulthood. She served as a youth minister, musician, praise and worship leader, and pastor;

culminating with her service within New Beginning Covenant Ministries under Bishop Daryl Butts.

Tyvette married the love of her life, Torrey Alan Brown of Salisbury Maryland on September 24, 2005, and was the loving mother of two wonderful children, Torrey Alan Brown, Jr., age 15, and Talven Joseph Brown, age 9.

Tyvette is predeceased by her brother, Eric J. Harmon and her father William Henry Ward, Jr.
