Vanessa Beryl (pronounced Berrell) Jones was born the seventh child to Beatrice L. Jones and the late James S. Jones, Sr. on Tuesday, January 27, 1959, in Pocomoke City, MD. She obediently responded to God's call of her name as He took her hand in His on Thursday, September 7, 2023.

Nessy, as we affectionately called her, was educated in the public schools of Worcester County, graduating from Pocomoke High School with the class of 1977. She was proud to be a Mighty Warrior and an avid basketball fan. She was a cheerleader during her high school years and remained a cheerleader out of uniform as a parent, an aunt and with any child who played the game. While her favorite sports team was the Washington Commanders, her favorite athlete of all time was Michael Jordan. In fact, she amassed an impressive collection of Chicago Bulls' games on VHS that she often rewatched with her son, fueling his love for the sport.

Vanessa was always a hard worker. She worked a full-time job and part-time

job(s) for more than twenty years. Places of employment included The Call Center, The Campbell Soup Company, Al-U-Glass, Mid Atlantic, Meatland, and Food City, just to name a few. Her most rewarding employment was with the Worcester County School System -- educating the children at Pocomoke Elementary School for nearly twenty-seven years. Ms. Jones loved her children and had a bonding relationship with her colleagues, touching all their lives in a special way. Her recent retirement (June of 2023) marked an end of an era, leaving behind a legacy of compassion, dedication, and unwavering support. Lastly, there's her Lowe's family, whom she loved dearly -- especially her supervisor, Scott, whom she thought she was his boss!

Vanessa served on Pocomoke City's Board of Elections Supervisors from 2010 to 2015. Eventually, she made the decision to step down from her position to create an opportunity for her nephew, Todd, to join the Board.

Vanessa was saved and baptized at the age of 12 by the late Bishop Isaac Jenkins, Sr. Vanessa loved her family, her New Macedonia church family, and more importantly, she loved God. 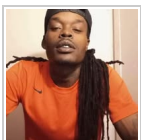
