Veronica Lynette Tilghman was born in Princess Anne, Maryland on August 27, 1967 to her late parents, William Bishop and Sarah Tilghman. After a valiant battle with lung cancer, Veronica transitioned from her earthly life to her eternal home promised in the Holy Scriptures, on Sunday, July 31, 2022 at the Tidal Health Peninsula Regional Hospital (Salisbury, MD).

Veronica’s educational foundation was established in the Somerset County School System. She always had an incredibly strong work ethic and took considerable pride in being a fierce protector and provider for her family. Professionally, she was known for providing extraordinary nursing services and comfort care to those in need, and was employed by

Manokin Manor, a senior community that provides memory care to the elderly.

Veronica, affectionately known to many as Ronnie, was extremely loved by her family, friends,

and co-workers. She embodied the cliché of “never meeting a stranger,” as she was friendly

and approachable to anyone and everyone – no one was a stranger, just a friend whom she had

not spoken to yet! She would often open her beloved home to relatives and friends seeking a

homecooked meal, temporary lodging, or a few words of encouragement.

Veronica loved life

and lived it to the fullest – she lived fearlessly, held nothing back, and poured her whole heart,

emotionally, spiritually, and physically, into those that she loved. Her annual birthday cookouts

are an example – each year, she invited and hosted countless numbers of relatives and friends

that would travel from near and far to celebrate the beauty of life, and she was always the life

of the party! Veronica was also known for her creativity – her hairstyles, jewelry/accessories,

clothing, and home décor choices were always bold, timeless, stylish, and trend-setting.

Yet, Veronica’s greatest joy was spending quality time with her family – she never wanted to

miss a birthday, graduation, shopping excursion, field trip, family reunion, or any other special

day/occasion! The bond that she shared with each family member was special and unique,

especially the connection with her granddaughter, Ashani, whom she raised

and nurtured since
infancy. Veronica now crosses her earthly “finish line” as an amazing, loving,
and devoted
mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, neighbor, cousin, friend, and confidant.
Veronica lived,
loved, and touched an array of individuals – especially those in need of care
and support. She
placed strong value on the concept of family – and never hesitated to sacrifice
her time or
resources in support of her children, grandchildren, siblings, nieces/nephews,
and close friends.
Veronica was always willing to lend a helping hand – her life was not in vain
and is
characterized by extraordinary courage and grace. She will be remembered
