



Wallace Ewell Jones Sr.

June 21, 1943 - February 12, 2024

Wallace Ewell Jones Sr., a native of Allen, Maryland, affectionately known as Nelson, departed this life on Monday, February 12th at Harborview Rehabilitation and Care Center in Lansdale, Pennsylvania. He was born June 21, 1943, to the loving parents of James Rollo Sr. and Gladys Elizabeth Jones of Allen, Maryland. He was eighty- years old.

Wallace was reared in a large and loving, spiritual home, and was one of 8 children. He attended school in the Wicomico County School District and graduated from Salisbury High School in 1961 before attending Maryland State College. In 1970 he moved his family to New Castle Delaware where he successfully completed computer programming classes and was employed by the Bank of Delaware (now known as PNC Bank) for 30 years.

He was also a faithful member of the Coleman Memorial United Methodist Church in New Castle, Delaware where he attended services and volunteered as an usher for devoted church patrons.

He was a devoted grandfather and loved spending as much time as possible with his three grandchildren. He was a dedicated supporter of Down Syndrome advocacy and participated in the Annual Down Syndrome Buddy Walk in Frederick Maryland in support of his granddaughter Hailey Rose. He we also an avid sports fan and enjoyed watching his beloved Philadelphia Eagles, 76ers and Philadelphia Phillies.

He is survived by his wife, Joan M. Jones (Anderson) of 62 years, daughter Waynet L. Jones, his son Wallace E. Jones Jr., daughter-in-law TinaMarie

Jones, and his loving grandchildren, Hailey Rose, Carley Elizabeth, and Jace Anderson. He also leaves two brothers: Marion (Martha) Baltimore, Maryland, Otto (Terry) Columbia, South Carolina, two sisters: Shelby Barkley Lincoln, Delaware, and Lottie Thompson Glen Burnie, Maryland. He also leaves a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
