Obituary

William Nathaniel Austin, Jr., aka, "NAT", son of the late Mamie Lou Smith Austin and William "Big Bill" Nathaniel Austin, Sr., was born on August 26, 1952 in Glen Arden, Maryland. After a short illness, he departed this life on Friday, August 23, 2024; just three days short of his 72nd birthday. He was surrounded by his dancing/singing girls, Adelynn and Allison, with their mom and his dedicated life partner, Delphine, at Coastal Hospice Deer's Head in Salisbury, MD.

Nat was educated in Dorchester County Schools, graduating from North Dorchester High School, Class of 1971. He loved sports and excelled in playing basketball and running track, helping to win State recognition. He served in the United States Army and received an honorable discharge in 1973. Later he obtained a barber's license and worked as a Maryland VET DOG-Puppy Trainer. Nat could always be found on the dance floor if Frankie Beverly and Maze "Before I Let Go" played at Mace's Lane Alumni functions. His two steps shall be greatly missed.

He happily joined Hurlock United Methodist Church on Sunday, December 18, 2016, under the leadership of Reverend Darlene Dixon and continued membership classes under Reverend Claudia Waters. Nat became active with

the Methodist Men (breakfast), and joined the Men's Chorus, The Willing Workers and could always be found singing and praying whenever asked.
